



Interlibrary Loans

BORROWED MATERIAL

The Library borrows materials from other institutions on behalf of eligible borrowers, under the general guidance of the Canadian Library Association's Interlibrary Loan Code. Borrowing rules conform to the *Interlibrary Loan Code for British Columbia Public Libraries*. Reasonable limits are placed on the number of Interlibrary Loans requests that can be placed at one time. Basic service is free, but any charges levied by lending institutions will be passed on to borrowers.

LOANED MATERIAL

The Library loans materials from our collections to other accredited institutions under the guidance of the Canadian Library Association's Interlibrary Loan Code. Lending rules conform to the *Interlibrary Loan Code for British Columbia Libraries*.

Borrowing libraries are referred to the Library's Interlibrary Loan Policy in the Symbols and Interlibrary Loan Policy Directory available on the Library and Archives website.
