



Displays of Community Information

The Board recognizes the Library's role as an institutional member of the community that can provide access to information regarding meetings or events in the local area. Accordingly, space is available in branches for the display of posters or pamphlets of interest to the community.

The Library accepts material for posting that includes a date relating to a specific event of social, cultural, informational, educational, recreational, political, or religious interest to the community.

Informational brochures and newsletters from non-profit organizations and groups are accepted for display purposes where space permits and for a time period determined by Library staff.

All items must be submitted to staff for consideration and remain the property of the Library. We do not guarantee materials will be posted in the branches. Given space limitations in the branches, materials are posted at the discretion of the CEO and/or designate.

The Library takes no position on the aims and objectives of groups whose material it posts or displays.

Material NOT acceptable for posting:

- advertisements or endorsements of private or corporate businesses whose main purpose is profit;
- material so large in size it excludes the posting of other items;
- material which omits essential information such as date, time, place, or fee;
- material which would violate the *BC Human Rights Act*; and
- petitions not approved by the CEO or designate.
