

Summer Challenge 2017 Rules
Greater Victoria Public Library

1. Entries. No purchase is necessary to participate in the contest draws. The contest is open to anyone residing in, or visiting, Greater Victoria. Winners are only eligible to win a maximum of one prize.
2. There are two ways to enter the contest. First way: Go to the GVPL Facebook page at gvpl.ca/facebook, and look for the Summer Challenge post pinned to the top of the page. Add a comment to the post that shows how you've completed the challenge, either by posting a photo or answering the question in the challenge. Please indicate the number of the challenge you've completed and include #gvplchallenge. Second way: Tweet @gvpl your completed challenge, either by posting a photo or answering the question in the challenge. Please indicate the number of the challenge you've completed and include #gvplchallenge. Note: Please make sure your social media privacy settings will allow us to see your submission.
3. All entries become the property of GVPL. GVPL is not responsible for lost, destroyed, misdirected or delayed entries. All entries must be completed and received during the contest entry period as noted below.
4. Number of Entries. Unlimited entries per person.
5. Contest Entry Periods. The contest begins on Thursday, July 6, 2017 at 9:00 am Pacific Time and ends on Thursday, August 31, 2017 at 9:00 pm Pacific Time. Only complete entries received within the contest entry period will be eligible for the random weekly draws. Ineligible entries will be discarded.
6. Draws. The winners of the prizes will be selected by random draw to be held on July 14, July 21, July 28, August 4, August 11, August 18, August 25 and September 1, 2017. Each week, one winner will be chosen from entries received between 12:00 am Thursday and 11:59 pm of the following Thursday. Dates are subject to change without notice. The winners will be notified on Facebook or Twitter.
7. Chances. The chances of winning a prize depend on the number of eligible entries received.
8. Prizes. One gift certificate to a local book store (valued at \$25).
9. Acceptance. Prizes must be accepted as awarded and are non-transferable and not redeemable in cash.
10. Decisions. The decisions are final and not subject to challenge.
11. Ineligibility. In the event that a contest winner is not eligible or cannot be contacted after reasonable efforts by GVPL, GVPL has the right to qualify another participant and GVPL is released from any liability or responsibility in this regard.
12. Rules. By entering the contest, each participant agrees to accept and abide by these rules.
13. Waiver. By entering the contest, each participant agrees that GVPL and its trustees, officers, employees, agents and assigns is not liable or responsible for any loss, damage or injury of any kind arising out of or in connection with the contest or the prizes awarded.

14. Privacy. By entering the contest, participants and winners consent to the use of personal information for the purposes of administering this contest and notifying the winner, unless permission is otherwise granted to receive additional information from GVPL.
